Dear parents,

Following discussions with many of you over the past two days, it is clear that the choice of sending your children back to school is one that weighs heavily on your minds. We as a school fully understand your concerns and dilemmas and respect your decision either way.

It will be lovely to see the children back for at school for weekly sessions, to meet their friends and see the staff. These sessions are likely to be pastoral sessions, with the focus being on the welfare of the children rather than getting on with lessons. My intention is to try to keep year groups together in small groups and, as I mentioned already, to try to ensure families come in on the same session. Currently, my preference is to offer days rather than half days, to make it more convenient for you as parents. I would also like to stick to the same day / half day weekly, for the benefit of the children, you and the staff.

However, until I receive the number of children returning to school, it's very difficult to see what this will look like. As soon as I have a timetable in place, I'll share it with you.

I would also like to assure you that as a school we will follow all the health and safety guidelines recommended by Ceredigion County Council.

For your information, I have attached the scientific document that was referred to by the Education Minister on Wednesday.
