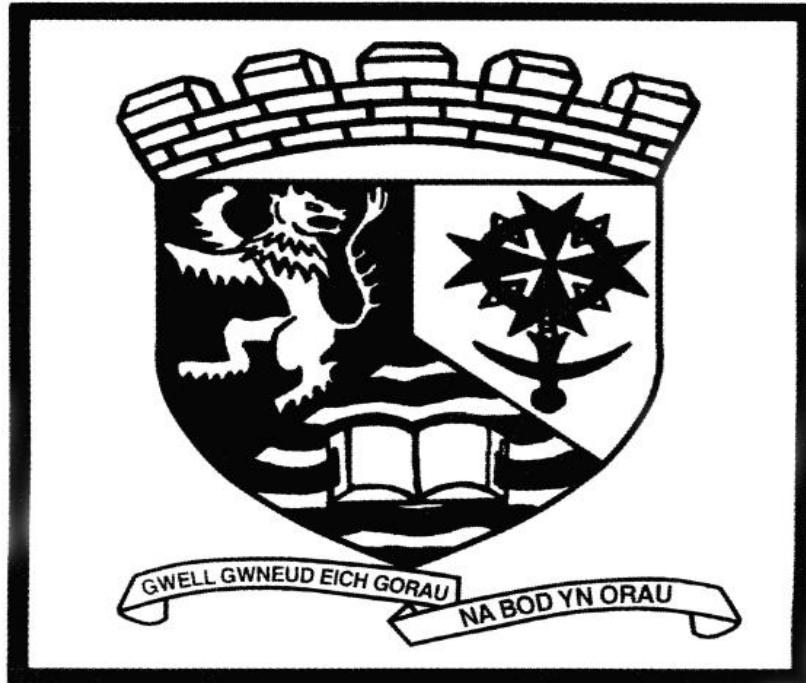

## **Cysylltiadau Cymunedol**

Mae ein hysgol yn chwarae rhan bwysig iawn yn y gymuned leol a'r gymuned ehangach. Mae hyn yn cynnwys cymuned yr ysgol, y gymuned ble lleolir yr ysgol ynghyd a gweddi Cymru. Yn ogystal y mae'r ysgol wedi bod yn rhan o Gymunedau Dysgu Proffesiynol (CDP) lle rhoddir pwyslais ar gydweithio gydag ysgolion eraill ar brosiectau penodol. Rydym yn sicrhau fod cwricwlwm ac ethos yn yr ysgol yn hybu'r syniad o hunaniaeth a chefnogi amrywiaeth, gan ddangos i'r disgyblion y gall gwahanol gymunedau weithio gyda'i gilydd er mwyn datblygu cymdeithas lwyddiannus.

## **Community links**

*Our school plays a very important part in the local and wider community. This includes the individual school community, the community within which the school is located, as well as other Welsh and global communities. In addition, the school has been a part of Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) where emphasis is put on working alongside other schools on a specific project. We ensure that the school's curriculum and ethos promotes a common sense of identity and supports diversity, showing pupils that different communities can work together to develop a coherent and successful society*

Rhoddir cyfleoedd eang i'n disgyblion gymryd rhan mewn gweithgareddau chwaraeon. Darperir gwersi Addysg Gorfforol yn wythnosol ar gyfer ein disgyblion, mewn gwersi dynodedig. Yn ogystal â hyn y mae disgyblion Bl 3-6 yn cael hyd at dymor o wersi nofio wythnosol. Mae nifer o ddisgyblion hefyd yn manteisio ar glybiau chwaraeon ar ôl ysgol, a drefnir gan staff yr Ysgol sef Clwb hoci a Clwb Chwaraeon yn nhymor yr Haf. Yn ystod y flwyddyn mae'r disgyblion yn cael cyfle i gymryd rhan mewn gemau tîm a gemau taro, nofio, gweithgareddau awyr agored, gymnasteg, dawns (traddodiadol a chreadigol) a gweithgareddau cadw'n heini.

## **Summary of the sports provision including provision made for extracurricular sports activities**

*Our pupils are able to participate in a wide variety of sporting activities. All pupils have a weekly PE lesson. Furthermore, pupils from Yr. 3-6 each have a term of weekly swimming lessons. Several pupils also take advantage of our after-school sports clubs, organised by our school staff which includes a hockey club and a sports club during the summer term. During the year pupils have the opportunity to take part in activities such as invasion and striking games, swimming, open-air activities, gymnastics, dance (traditional and creative) and fitness activities.*

*The school sports were held on June 20<sup>th</sup>, with Ystwyth winning the School Trophy. The boy who achieved the highest marks was William Noble and Leila Unett achieved the highest marks of the girls.*

## **Cynhwysiant**

Ceisïa'r ysgol sicrhau fod pob plentyn yn cael eu cynhwyso fel aelodau llawn o gymuned yr ysgol ac yn sgil hyn yn cael darpariaeth addysgol briodol o safon uchel a mynediad i gwricwlwm eang, cytbwys a pherthnasol. Ceisir adnabod disgyblion sy'n cael anawsterau'n gynnar gan dargedu cymorth perthnasol. Pan gredai athro fod anghenion gan blentyn mae'n nodi ei ddiffygion addysgol ac yn trafod gyda'r SENCO a'r Pennaeth. Cyn rhoi plentyn ar gam priodol y gofrestr addysg arbennig byddwn bob amser yn gofyn caniatâd y rhieni, a lle bo'n briodol, gofyn barn y plentyn.

Ymdrechir i gadw mewn cysylltiad â'r rhieni gan eu gwahodd i'r ysgol yn ystod tymor yr Hydref i gyfrannu sylwadau ar Gynllun Addysg Unigol eu plentyn. Danfonir copi o GAU am weddill y flwyddyn adref er gwybodaeth. Mae pob athro yn yr ysgol yn ymwybodol o bwysigrwydd gwahaniaethu er mwyn darparu addysg gyflawn a pherthnasol i'r disgyblion. Yn dibynnu ar y dasg, mae gwahaniaethu yn digwydd o ran lefel y gwaith, marcio a chanmoliaeth, disgwyliadau a threfniadaeth dosbarth, h.y. gweithio mewn pâr, grŵp neu'n unigol.

Mae'r ysgol yn darparu ar gyfer disgyblion ag anghenion addysgol arbennig drwy'r dulliau canlynol:

- Rhoi cynorthwyr i mewn yn y dosbarth i roi cymorth i ddisgyblion ag anghenion arbennig.
- Cawn wasanaeth Miss Nia Evans sy'n gweithio gyda grwpiau bychain o blant sydd angen sylw ychwanegol/Grwpiau Ymyrraeth.
- Gwasanaeth Miss Nia Jones i weithio gydag unigolion i gyflawni gwaith Elsa ac i ddarllen gydag unigolion.
- Defnyddio cynlluniau gwaith gwahaniaethol tu mewn i grwpiau gallu cymysg.
- Mae aelod penodedig o fewn yr Ysgol (Mrs Rhiannon Salisbury) yn gyfrifol am drefniant addysg plant ag Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig.
- Mae un aelod o'r Corff Llywodraethol â chyfrifoldeb dros Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig.
- Ymgynghori a chydweithio gydag Ymgynghorwyr Addysg Arbennig ac asiantaethau allanol.

*Our curriculum seeks to ensure that all learners in our school are engaged as full members of the school community, accessing the wider curriculum and all school activities. ### **Inclusion**

*The school aims to ensure that every pupil with additional needs receives a high standard of educational provision and has access to a curriculum that has breadth, balance and relevance. Children who are having difficulties are identified as early as possible and support is then targeted. When a teacher believes that a pupil requires additional support he/she will make a note of any difficulties and discuss the matter with the SENCO and the Head-teacher. Parental permission will always be sought before placing a child on the special educational needs register and, where appropriate, the child's view will also be taken into account.*

*The school aims to keep parents well informed and invite them to school during the Autumn term to discuss progress and to comment on their child's Individual Education Plan. Copies of additional IEP's during the year are sent home for parents' information. Every teacher is aware of the importance of differentiation in order to provide a full and relevant education to his or her pupils. Depending on the nature of the task, differentiation will focus on the level of the work, marking and praise, expectations and class management, i.e. working in pairs, groups or individually.*

*Children with special educational needs are provided for in the following ways:*

- *The presence of additional learning support assistants in the class to give support to pupils with special needs.*
- *The withdrawal of pupils from their classes for a short period of time with Miss Nia Evans the Learning Support staff member.*
- *The support of Miss Nia Jones to work with individuals to complete Elsa work and to read with individuals.*
- *The use of differentiated schemes of work in mixed ability teaching groups.*
- *There is one teacher within the school (Mrs Rhiannon Salisbury) with specific responsibility for Special Educational Needs*
- *The Governing Body has a designated person with responsibility for Special Educational Needs.*
- *Consultation and liaison with SEN Advisors and outside agencies.*

### **Addysg Cyfrwng Cymraeg (yn bennaf)**

Y cwricwlwm – Mae pob disgybl yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen yn cael profiad o'r meysydd dysgu drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Cymraeg yw'r prif gyfrwng addysgu yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 2 ac mae o leiaf 80% o'r addysgu drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Caiff Saesneg ei gyflwyno yn ffurfiol fel pwnc yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 2 a chaiff ei addysgu drwy gyfrwng y Saesneg, ac mae'n bosibl y defnyddir Saesneg hefyd ar gyfer rai agweddau ar rai pynciau.

Y canlyniadau - Fel rheol, disgwylir y bydd disgyblion, beth bynnag yw iaith y cartref, yn gallu trosglwyddo'n hawdd i ddarpariaeth uwchradd cyfrwng Cymraeg ac y byddant wedi cyrraedd, erbyn diwedd Cyfnod Allweddol 2, yr un safon yn Saesneg â disgyblion mewn ysgolion sydd, yn bennaf, yn rhai cyfrwng Saesneg.

## **Datganiad byr am ddarpariaeth toiledau a'r trefniadau am eu glanhau**

Mae gan yr ysgol y nifer digonol o doiledau ar gyfer y disgyblion ac fe'u glanheir i safon dda iawn. Cafodd ciwbiclau newydd eu gosod yn ystod Haf 2019. Mae toiled anabl ar gael yn yr ysgol.

### ***The language category that most closely describes the school***

*The school is defined as a "2 A" category school, in accordance with Assembly guidelines.*

### ***Welsh medium education***

***Curriculum***– *all pupils in the Foundation Phase experience the areas of learning through the medium of Welsh. Welsh is the main teaching medium at KS2 with at least 80% of the teaching through the medium of Welsh. English is introduced formally as a subject at Key Stage 2 and is taught through the medium of English, and English may occasionally be used for some aspects of some subjects.*

***Outcomes*** – *The normal expectation is that pupils, regardless of home language, will be able to transfer easily to Welsh medium secondary provision and by the end of Key Stage 2 will have reached a standard in English equivalent to that reached by pupils in predominantly English medium schools.*
